

Worksheet Seashell necklace

What do you need?

- Seashells
- Beads
- String to make a necklace from
- A needle or push-pin
- Scissors
- An adult assistant



Step 1

Collect shells on the beach or buy a box of shells at a museum, among other places.

Wash the shells you found on the beach well before using them.



Step 2

Some shells already have a hole through which you can thread the string.

If not, use the push-pin or needle and ask your assistant to help:

Wiggle, poke, twist and push on the spot where you want the hole to be. With a little patience, a hole will form eventually.

Step 3

Once you have made a hole then you can thread the string through it.

Further decorate your necklace with beads, letters or lots of different shells.

Tip:

You can also paint the shells or stick glitter on them for an extra colourful necklace.



Step 4

Time to shine!

Show everyone your unique shell necklace. Or make some more to give away as gifts.
