

Worksheet Bee drinking station



What do you need?

- An adult assistant
- A small glass jar with a separate lid
- A plate or small bowl
- Stones (of various sizes) and/or marbles
- A nail
- A hammer



Step 1

Ask your adult assistant to poke a few holes in the lid.

Use the nail and the hammer to do this.



Step 2

Fill your bowl with stones of various sizes and marbles.

Flat stones work best.



Step 3

Fill the jar with water and screw the lid on very tightly.

Turn the jar upside down, with the lid facing downwards, and place it on top of the stones.

You've now created a safe drinking spot for thirsty bees!



Tips!



Place your drinking station in the shade.



Change the water every few days.



Do **not** add sugar to the water!



Make your drinking station look extra nice by painting the jar and the bowl.
